Sacrament of Baptism (newborns - age 6): Come by the office to sign up for the class and to obtain a list of requirements. The next class will be at 7 p.m. on Thursday, July 13th in the church Four Evangelists Hall. All requirements must be met at least 30 days prior to date of baptism. Once everything has been reviewed, you will receive a confirmation from the office.

Fr. Karl Reflection

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ
and the love of God
and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.

These words we all know so well come from II Corinthians. As we consider the Holy Trinity we look at the very nature of God. The Church has taught a number of things about the Trinity but still the nature of God is veiled in mystery—but only because we have difficulty understanding. We believe that God is three persons; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are coeternal and all are of equal dignity. Three persons yet one Godhead. Such statements are a bit difficult to understand for the average person yet the mystery of the Holy Trinity becomes more understandable when we think about personal experiences.

The Trinity is best explained by saying that the nature of God is communal. We believe that God is love and love must always be directed toward someone or something. God the Father loves the Son—and flowing eternally from their love is the Holy Spirit. From personal experience we know that love must be expressed: it is impossible to “love” without loving someone or something. Parents love their children. Children love their parents. Husbands love their wives and wives love their husbands.

God loves us enough that he makes himself fully knowable through our human experience. As followers of Christ and good Catholics let us proclaim the love of God to those who seek!

Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad

La gracia del Señor Jesucristo
Y el amor de Dios
Y la comunión del Espíritu Santo sea con todos ustedes.

Estas palabras que todos conocemos tan bien vienen de II Corintios. Al considerar la Santísima Trinidad, miramos la naturaleza misma de Dios. La Iglesia ha enseñado una serie de cosas acerca de la Trinidad, más la naturaleza de Dios está cubierta por el misterio, pero solamente porque tenemos dificultad para comprenderlo. Creemos que Dios es tres personas; Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo son coeternos y todos son de igual dignidad. Tres personas, una Divinidad. Tales declaraciones son un poco difíciles de entender, pero el misterio de la Santísima Trinidad se hace más comprensible cuando se piensa en experiencias personales.

La Trinidad se explica mejor diciendo que la naturaleza de Dios es comunal. Creemos que Dios es amor y el amor siempre debe estar dirigido hacia alguien o algo. Dios Padre ama al Hijo y es el Espíritu Santo que fluye eternamente de su amor. Por experiencia personal sabemos que el amor debe ser expresado: es imposible “amar” sin amar a alguien o algo. Los padres aman a sus hijos. Los niños aman a sus padres. Los esposos aman a sus esposas y las esposas a sus esposos.

Dios nos ama lo suficiente como para hacerse plenamente presente y reconocible a través de nuestra experiencia humana. ¡Como seguidores de Cristo y buenos católicos, proclamemos el amor de Dios a los que lo buscan!
