Sacrament of Baptism (newborns - age 6): Come by the office to sign up for the class and to obtain a list of requirements. The next class will be at 7 p.m. on Thursday, July 13th in the church Four Evangelists Hall. All requirements must be met at least 30 days prior to date of baptism. Once everything has been reviewed, you will receive a confirmation from the office.

Fr. Karl Reflection

Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me.”

The relationship of parents to their children is the strongest natural bond we ever experience. So when Jesus asks his disciples to love him more than their children he is asking for a lot—perhaps even, he is asking the impossible. Jesus’ words challenge us to think and to reconsider our relationship with God.

As Catholics we believe that children are a blessing that comes from God. God who created us knows us perfectly—He understands our natural instincts. The love of a parent for a child comes from within; it is instinctual—visceral. Christ would never ask us to love our children less—rather, He is asking us to love God more. Using our common human experience as a reference Jesus explains the depth of love He is seeking. We are incapable of this kind of love on a natural level but on the supernatural level all things are possible with God. Today we are invited to enter into the mystery of God’s love and come to love God more each day. Even with our human limitations we are called to love God perfectly.

Decimotercero Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

"El que ama a su padre o a su madre más que a mí, no es digno de mí, y el que ama a su hijo o a su hija más que a mí no es digno de mí; y el que no toma su cruz y me sigue, no es digno de mí."

La relación de los padres con sus hijos es el vínculo natural más fuerte que jamás hemos experimentado. Así que cuando Jesús pide a sus discípulos que lo amen más que a sus hijos, Él está pidiendo mucho - tal vez incluso, Él está pidiendo algo imposible. Las palabras de Jesús nos desafían a pensar y a reconsiderar nuestra relación con Dios.

Como católicos creemos que los niños son una bendición que viene de Dios. Dios que nos creó nos conoce perfectamente, entiende nuestros instintos naturales. El amor de un padre por un hijo viene de adentro; Es instintivo-de las entrañas. Cristo nunca nos pedirá que amemos a nuestros hijos menos, sino que Él nos está pidiendo que amemos a Dios más. Usando nuestra experiencia humana común como referencia, Jesús explica la profundidad del amor que Él está buscando. Somos incapaces de esta forma de amor en un nivel natural, pero en el nivel sobrenatural todas las cosas son posibles con Dios. Hoy estamos invitados a entrar en el misterio del amor de Dios y llegar a amar a Dios cada día más. Incluso con nuestras limitaciones humanas estamos llamados a amar a Dios perfectamente.
