Father Karl's Reflection

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

While they were eating,
he took bread, said the blessing,
broke it, gave it to them, and said,
"Take it; this is my body."
Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them,
and they all drank from it.
He said to them,
"This is my blood of the covenant,
which will be shed for many."

Today's celebration of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is the last "special" celebration before we start a long series of "Sundays of Ordinary Time." Today's celebration is a special commemoration of Christ's institution of the Eucharist, the Mass. In years past this celebration was simply named Corpus Christi or "Body of Christ." The title has been changed to specifically mention the Eucharist because it would be possible to confuse it with a commemoration of the Body of Christ as the Church, or the People of God. But today's celebration specifically concerns the Mass.

It is important to note that Jesus gave his disciples a very clear command to continue this celebration as a perpetual memorial. Jesus is also clear that he is offering his disciples his true Body and Blood as food and drink. Jesus links the Eucharist with his own redemptive death and resurrection—his sacrifice on the cross. At each celebration of Mass we are present at the saving moment of Christ's redemption. As we read through the Gospel today from Mark it is also important to see that Jesus commands us to "eat" and "drink." As Catholics, as orthodox Christians, we are people of the table. Our true relationship with Christ is forged at the Altar of God. This is why the Second Vatican Council teaches that the celebration of the Mass is "the source and summit of the life of the Church." In the truest sense the celebration of Mass "makes" the Church. Our participation in the Eucharist invites us into the very heart of the Gospel. Attending Mass, actively participating, and most importantly receiving communion make us who we are—the Body of Christ (the Church).

In our self-absorbed society, it can be difficult to understand why the celebration of Mass is so important, or why our presence at Mass is essential. We have so many options; there are more "interesting" things to do. The one hour that we spend each week at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the most important hour of our week. Receiving our Lord in Holy Communion is the most important thing that we can ever do. To better appreciate the importance of Mass we need to learn more about the meaning of Mass. It always astounds me that people know all the characters from television shows like Game of Thrones or 50 Shades of Grey but they don't have basic knowledge of what is going on at the celebration of Mass. In the coming months there will be some special opportunities for adult formation specifically concerning the Mass—please come.

Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo

Mientras cenaban, Jesús tomó un pan,
pronunció la bendición,
lo partió y se lo dio a sus discípulos, diciendo:
"Tomen: esto es mi cuerpo".
Y tomando en sus manos una copa de vino,
pronunció la acción de gracias, se la dio,
todos bebieron y les dijo:
"Ésta es mi sangre, sangre de la alianza,
que se derrama por todos."

La celebración de la solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo es la última celebración "especial" antes de comenzar una larga serie de "Domingos del Tiempo Ordinario". La celebración de hoy es una conmemoración especial de la institución de la Eucaristía de Cristo, la Misa. En años pasados, esta celebración simplemente se llamó Corpus Christi o "Cuerpo de Cristo". El título ha sido cambiado para mencionar específicamente la Eucaristía, porque sería posible confundirla con una conmemoración del Cuerpo de Cristo como la Iglesia, o el Pueblo de Dios. Pero la celebración de hoy se refiere específicamente a la Misa.

Es importante notar que Jesús dio a sus discípulos un mandato muy claro para continuar esta celebración como un memorial perpetuo. Jesús también tiene claro que está ofreciendo a sus discípulos su verdadero Cuerpo y Sangre como alimento y bebida. Jesús vincula la Eucaristía con su propia muerte redentora y resurrección, su sacrificio en la cruz. En cada celebración de la Misa, estamos presentes en el momento de salvación de la redención de Cristo. Al leer el Evangelio de Marcos hoy, también es importante ver que Jesús nos ordena "comer" y "beber". Como católicos, como cristianos ortodoxos, somos personas de la mesa. Nuestra verdadera relación con Cristo se forja en el Altar de Dios. Es por esto que el Concilio Vaticano II enseña que la celebración de la Misa es "la fuente y la cumbre de la vida de la Iglesia". En el verdadero sentido, la celebración de la Misa "hace" a la Iglesia. Nuestra participación en la Eucaristía nos invita al corazón del Evangelio. Asistir a la misa, participar activamente y, lo más importante, recibir la comunión, nos hacen lo que somos: el Cuerpo de Cristo (la Iglesia).

En nuestra sociedad ensimismada, puede ser difícil entender por qué la celebración de la Misa es tan importante, o por qué nuestra presencia en la Misa es esencial. Tenemos tantas opciones; hay más cosas "interesantes" que hacer. La hora que pasamos cada semana en el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa es la hora más importante de nuestra semana. Recibir a nuestro Señor en la Sagrada Comunión es lo más importante que podemos hacer. Para apreciar mejor la importancia de la Misa, necesitamos aprender más sobre el significado de la Misa. Siempre me sorprende que las personas conozcan a todos los personajes de programas de televisión como Game of Thrones o 50 Shades of Grey, pero no tienen un conocimiento básico de lo que está sucediendo en la celebración de la Misa. En los próximos meses habrá algunas oportunidades especiales para la formación de adultos específicamente sobre la Misa, por favor vengan.
